Anne Salonen is a research scientist at University of Helsinki, Finland. She has multidisciplinary training in biosciences and PhD in microbiology (2004). Her research activities are focused on the composition and activity of the intestinal microbiota in health and disease (MetS, IBS, IBD) with links to nutrition and biomedicine. Research methodology is mainly based on phylogenetic microarray (HITChip) and intestinal metaproteomics.

She works with Professor Willem de Vos and has expertise on molecular microbiology and microbial ecology. She is a member of European Network for Gastrointestinal health Research (ENGIHR), vice Finnish representative in the management group of COST Action BM1106 “The Genes in Irritable Bowel Syndrome Research Network Europe” (GENIEUR), and member of F1000 Research’s Editorial Board.
